The problem with fire officials requesting visual inspections of turbine sumps on a weekly basis was discussed in detail. The rationale for the request is found in the Fire Code but it is thought that this long-existing requirement has been used since pumps were entirely aboveground. There are other provisions for use of electronic monitoring that should have precedence over service station personnel lifting heavy lids to do a visual inspection of turbine sumps. A committee that comprises, Howard Heal, Al Lemoine, Norm Dekens and Don Edgecombe will write to the Government of Alberta requesting a Standata be prepared to address this issue on a province-wide basis. Communications with government will be done through Al Lemoine.
